The Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) is offering an opportunity for individuals to make a difference in the lives of Children and Youth with Support Needs in British Columbia.

In your role as a Children and Youth with Support Needs Generalist (CYSN), you may provide a combination of Family Support and guardianship functions. From an integrated service delivery system in the MCFD you may assist with placements, services for children, liaise and monitor contracts for services and ensure contract compliance and quality/appropriateness of services.

Qualifications for this role include:

Applicants may be considered who meet the preferred OR expanded credentials and experience requirements

1. Preferred Credentials:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher in social work or in child & youth care OR master's degree in educational counselling psychology/Master of Arts in counselling psychology with completion of a practicum in family and child welfare OR
- In-service MCFD employees who have a regular SPO 24-30 base position that requires delegation under the Child, Family and Community Services Act (CFCSA) OR
- A candidate may be considered equivalent when they are registered and a member in good standing with the BC College of Social Workers or has a letter from the college confirming that their application for registration has been approved.

2. Expanded Credentials:

- Bachelor's degree in a human services field OR bachelor's degree with a major/honors in a human services field OR master's level graduate certificate/diploma in a human services field AFTER the completion of an unrelated bachelor's degree.
- PLUS, a minimum of one (1) year of related OR job-specific work experience.
- Other combinations of education and experience may be considered.
