### **Job Summary:**

The Child Care Worker at New Beginnings will plan and implement a developmentally appropriate child care program, offering a nurturing environment for the care of children. This position will require knowledge of the Early Learning Framework and will work in close cooperation with the Child Care Supervisor, school staff and other Child Care Workers.

### **Your Role:**

Archway's Child Care Worker with the New Beginnings Young Parent Program contributes by:

- Working with the child, family, staff, and supervisor to provide an engaging early childhood experience for a child needing extra support.
- Carrying out developmentally appropriate activities and experiences for the child, which may include indoor/outdoor, and active/quiet activities.
- Attending to the child's physical needs which may include toileting, eating, sleeping, and other basic needs.
- Attending to the child's psychological and emotional needs which may include cuddling, rocking, and holding the child.
- Providing a healthy, safe, caring and nurturing environment.
- Building and maintaining relationships with the parents/caregivers, either in person or over the phone.
- Using the Early Learning Framework and emergent curriculum to provide an environment that reflects the interests of the child.
