We are seeking a Registered Nurse to join our team in the Dementia Care Program. Nursing Key Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with physicians, therapists, social workers, and other professionals to plan and evaluate client care; attend multidisciplinary care meetings
- Encourage and support residents' participation in rehabilitation, recreational, and community activities to foster life skills, confidence, and social relationships
- Administer medications and treatments; closely monitor, record, and report symptoms and changes in health status
- Provide counselling, health guidance, and support to clients and their families, including home care instructions
- Prepare facilities, equipment, and supplies; assist with examinations, and treatments
- Train and supervise unregulated care providers and support staff as appropriate
- Assist residents with activities of daily living (feeding, transfers, hygiene, toileting, etc.)
- Maintain accurate documentation and communicate changes to the care team
