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### **Job Summary**

The Homeless Outreach and Prevention Programs Worker (HOPP) are responsible for providing services to connect people who are homeless or at risk of homelessness with housing options, income assistance, community-based support services and will endeavor to reduce the time that individuals who are absolutely homeless remain on the street in the community. Where appropriate assistance is also given to landlords to ensure the safe and affordable housing can be maintained. HOPP operates within the requirements of BC Housing Homeless Outreach Program and Homeless Prevention Program Framework. This program assists people in identified at-risk groups who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness. **The Homeless Outreach and Prevention Programs Worker** are responsible for providing rental supplement and support services to eligible individuals to help them access/maintain rental housing in the private (unsubsidized) housing market. Support services can include referrals to landlords and a variety of community agencies for either the Homeless Prevention or Homeless Outreach Programs.

- Non-Violent Crisis Prevention or de-escalation training preferred

- Must be sensitive to and respectful of cultural differences, differences in socio-economic status and lifestyle diversity. Must be non-judgmental.
