**Job Summary:**

The Supported Visit Program provides supervised visits for children and their parents. The Supported Visit Worker (SVW) is responsible for facilitating the visitation sessions and ensuring visits are emotionally and physically safe for children. The SVW is responsible for monitoring the visits and documenting interactions during the visits as well as facilitating exchanges between caregiver and parent.

**Key Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Provides supported visitation in conjunction with referring Social Worker. Collaborates/ consults with social worker, clients, foster parents or other involved parties. If requested provides transportation to and from visits.
- Gathers information relevant to the client's visits, needs and risks by observing behaviour. Assesses the information gathered to identify client problems, risks and strengths.
- Outlines services provided by the program and/or organization. Provides information on and referral to other community service providers, resources and professionals as required.

- If requested by the Social Worker the Supported Visit Worker will provide parenting skills to clients on issues such as parent-child interaction, child development, discipline and guidance, and behaviour management.
- Maintains records and statistics and provides reports to the referring source.
- Closely monitors interactions between parents and writes reports on observed interactions.
- Performs other related duties as required.

#### **Qualifications:**

#### **Education and Experience**

- Bachelor's degree in a related human/social service field or diploma and One (1) year recent related experience. Or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.

#### **Job Skills and Abilities:**

- Well developed interpersonal and communication skills.
- Good organization, time and general management skills.
- Ability to complete paperwork and reports in a timely manner.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Required to work outside normal office hours.

#### **Additional Information:**

- Criminal record check is required.
- Union (CUPE) Membership required.
- This position is open to all qualified applicants
- Valid Driver's Licence and use of personal vehicle with appropriate business class insurance may be required.
